
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Hoboken Maritime Park in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Hoboken, located at 94 Washington Street, Hoboken, New Jersey 07030. The funding would be used to redevelop a former industrial site into a resilient waterfront public park along the Hudson River with flood-resilient features that will improve water quality protection and storm surge mitigation. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will strengthen shoreline protection and expand equitable waterfront access to a high-density urban area with limited open space.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
