## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Commu-
- 5 nities from Helicopter Noise Act".

## 21 SEC. 2. STUDY ON HELICOPTER OPERATIONS. 2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Federal 3 Aviation Administration shall conduct a study on helicopter operations within a 15 mile radius of the Statue 4 5 of Liberty National Monument. 6 (b) CONTENTS.—In conducting the study under sub-7 section (a), the Administrator shall focus on the following 8 items: 9 (1) The effect of persistent helicopter noise on 10 residential and recreational areas, including— 11 (A) an analysis of the volume of helicopter 12 traffic, including the time helicopters are flying 13 and the frequency of helicopters traversing the 14 airspace;

15 (B) an analysis of noise levels related to16 helicopter operations;

17 (C) an analysis of safety, health, environ18 mental, and economic issues related to heli19 copter operations;

20 (D) an analysis of whether helicopters are
21 following the terms and conditions of voluntary
22 agreements, including the Statue of Liberty Na23 tional Monument and Governors Island Na24 tional Monument Voluntary Agreement;

(E) an analysis of the origination of heli-copters traversing the airspace within a 15 mile

3	(F) an analysis of the necessity of heli-
4	copter traffic within a 15 mile radius of the

6	(G) an analysis of the quality of life of
7	residents living in areas with high volumes of
8	helicopter noise; and
9	(H) an analysis of any other issue related
10	to helicopter traffic on residential and rec-
11	reational areas.
12	(2) Solutions to abate or eliminate helicopter
13	noise on residential and recreational areas, includ-
14	ing—
15	(A) the feasibility of diverting helicopters
16	from residential and recreational areas;
17	(B) the feasibility of creating new flight
18	paths for helicopters, with attention to the pres-
19	ence of airports within a 15 mile radius of the
20	Statue of Liberty National Monument;
21	(C) the feasibility of establishing altitude
22	limits for helicopter operations in and around
23	within a 15 mile radius of the Statue of Liberty
24	National Monument; and

1 (D) other options for abating helicopter 2 noise.

3 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
4 of enactment of this Act, the Administrator shall submit
5 to Congress a report on the study under subsection (a).
